1. Call to Order

Supervisor Eddie Bedford called the meeting to order commencing at 7:02 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

3. Presentation from Elected Officials

Supervisor Bedford presented a Power Point regarding the history of Road District consolidation attempts and the current referendum on the 2019 municipal ballot.

4. Public Comments

Invitation to speak to any issue on the agenda or anything regarding Township government. (Limited to one 3-minute comment per person)

Jim Kubor – Is an unincorporated resident, does not see the Lisle/Naperville Township consolidation as effective. Does not want to combine. Asked if anything would stop the Board from turning services over to the City of Naperville.

Lisle Township Highway Commissioner Ed Young – Engaged in conversation giving brief comments regarding employee pensions, how IGA's within the Road District work, and why Township road services cost less than the City's.

Pam from League of Women Voters – Asked if there have ever been discussion of the City of Naperville taking over any road services. Spoke about City issues with brush pickup.

David Stevens – Asked what the benefits of the original merger might be. Asked if the new referendum is better for Naperville Township only.
